Kelli also offered to give us an update on our goals as well as teach us more about any topic the Coalition chooses. Subcommittees Meet & Report Out	<p>Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Tobacco</u> Elizabeth will be presenting at the Fire Chief's Meeting in October regarding Tobacco-Free Grounds, Sunnie looked into tabling at Clute Park Market but was told that it is too late to sign up this year, Sunnie is trying to recruit more youth for Reality Check from Schuyler County Schools, and Sarah is looking for more tobacco policy targets in the county. • <u>Outreach</u> completed their presentation to the Bradford Superintendent and other representatives from Bradford CSD and it went well. Bradford has committed to start the Too Good for Drugs Program in grades K-2 in November. Grades 7 and 10 are scheduled to start the program in the spring. Outreach will be presenting to the new Watkins Glen Superintendent, Greg Kelahan, at the Executive Board Meeting on August 4th. • <u>Alcohol</u> Looked at which local counties have a social host law. They will try to obtain more information from those counties. They also looked at how to reach more youth and parents using social media. They discussed creating a social media campaign on the social host law and tip-line. Raising awareness was also discussed, possibly having an incentive for people to like or share our page. • <u>Rx</u> They would like to partner with STAND to possibly start a campaign on other social media sites (Snapchat/Instagram) that students use more often. They also discussed having a forum on prescription pain relievers and heroin in October during Red Ribbon Week. They looked at possible venues like the school, community center, and the PAC at the old middle school.
