RE: INTRODUCE LOCAL LAW A OF THE YEAR 2021 “A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING 12 AND 13-YEAR-OLD LICENSED HUNTERS TO HUNT DEER WITH A FIREARM OR CROSSBOW DURING HUNTING SEASON WITH THE SUPERVISION OF AN ADULT LICENSED” - COUNTY CLERK’S DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, deer hunting is a valued tradition for many Schuyler County families, providing quality food to county residents and reducing the negative impacts of overabundant deer populations on our agriculture, forests, and communities, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the recently enacted New York State Environmental Conservation Law Section 11-0935, in upstate counties that choose to participate, youth hunters aged 12-13 will now be allowed to hunt deer with a firearm or crossbow under the supervision of an experienced adult hunter; currently, young hunters that are 12 or 13 years old can already hunt big game using archery equipment and can hunt small game with a firearm; however, until now, New York had been the only state to not allow these young hunters to hunt big game with a firearm, and

WHEREAS, the state legislation requires each County to "opt-in" and notify the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) of its adoption by September 1, 2021 in order for this information to be posted for hunters on DEC's website leading into the 2021 big game seasons, and

WHEREAS, the Schuyler County Clerk, as local agent of the DEC for retail sales of hunting and fishing licenses to the public, endorses this proposed local law, and

WHEREAS, the Schuyler County Sheriff and Undersheriff endorse this proposed local law, and

WHEREAS, the Schuyler County Attorney, as the prosecuting agency for juveniles accused of firearms violations under the Family Court Act, endorses this proposed local law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Local Law Intro. A of the year 2021 be, and hereby is, introduced in the form hereto annexed pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing shall be held upon said proposed Local Law on June 14, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. in Room 120 at the Human Services Complex, 323 Owego Street, Montour Falls, NY.

LOCAL LAW INTRO. A OF THE YEAR 2021

A Local Law authorizing 12 and 13-year-old licensed hunters to hunt deer with a firearm or crossbow during hunting season with the supervision of an adult licensed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the County of Schuyler as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

The intent of this Local Law is to authorize Schuyler County to permit 12 and 13-year-old individuals to participate in the new and safe hunting opportunities in accordance with Environmental Conservation Law § 11-0935. The enacted 2021-2022 New York State Budget, include a pilot program, allowing the opportunity for young hunters, ages 12 and 13, to hunt deer with firearms and crossbow through 2023 if a county authorizes such action within their municipality. Schuyler County is passing this local law as hunting is a

valued tradition for many families, and this new opportunity allows experienced, adult hunters to introduce the value of hunting to the next generation. Furthermore, teaching young people safe, responsible, and ethical hunting practices will ensure a rewarding experience for the youth, while providing quality food to families and contributing to important deer management population control practices. This local law has been reviewed and endorsed by the Schuyler County Clerk, County Sheriff, Undersheriff and County Attorney in their official capacities.

Section 2. Pilot Program Authorization

Pursuant to Environmental Conservation Law, ECL Sec. 11-0935, Schuyler County elects to participate in the temporary program to allow for young hunters, ages twelve (12) and thirteen (13), to hunt deer with a firearm, to include rifles, shotguns, and muzzle loaded firearms or crossbow through 2023.

Section 3. State Requirements to Adhere Once Authorized

Twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old licensed hunters shall be allowed to hunt deer with the following requirements to be followed:

- Twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old licensed hunters shall be under the supervision of a licensed adult hunter, age 21 years or older, with a rifle, shotgun, or muzzle loading firearm in areas where and during the hunting season in which such firearms may be used, and
- Twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old licensed hunters shall be allowed to hunt deer under the supervision of a licensed adult hunter, age 21 years or older, with a crossbow during the times when other hunters may use crossbows, and
- Supervision of a licensed adult hunter, age twenty-one (21) years or older, with at least three (3) years of experience who exercises dominion and control over the youth hunter at all times is required, and
- All licensed twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old hunters as well as their adult supervisors shall be required to wear fluorescent orange or pink clothing while engaged in hunting to an extent and covering so designated pursuant to the law, rules, and regulations promulgated by the State of New York, and
- All licensed twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old hunters as well as their adult supervisors shall remain at ground level while such youth hunters are hunting deer with a crossbow, rifle, shotgun, or muzzleloader, and
- Notwithstanding any State or Federal Law to the contrary, this local law shall not authorize the hunting of bear by twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old with a firearm or crossbow.

Section 4. Local Law Filing Requirements

A copy of this local law shall be sent to the New York State Department of Conservation as well as the New York State Department of State

Section 5. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law, or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, effect or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or in its application to the person, individual, corporation,

firm, partnership, entity or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing and publication in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule.
